



## PRE-KINDERGARTEN 3

(\*REPLENISH MID-YEAR)

- \* 3 Large tissue boxes
- \* 2 large containers of disinfecting wipes
- 4 boxes of *flushable* wipes
- 3 boxes of baby wipes or refill
- 2 tooth brushes (write your child's name on them)
- 1 bottle of *Elmer's* Clear glue gel
- 1 box of *Crayola* washable markers
- 1 box of Dry erase markers
- Spare clothing
- A small pillow and blanket for naptime
- 1 pack of play dough

## PRE-KINDERGARTEN 4

- 1 Al-Iman School Red Shirt
- 1 pack of moon sand (kinetic sand) **blue, green or yellow only**

- 4 Large Boxes of Tissue

- 1 Package of WASHABLE Markers
- 1 Scissors, round point
- 1 pack of side walk chalk

- A small blanket for naptime
- 1 Box of Ziploc Bags- Gallon
- 1 Box of Sandwich Bags- Small
- 2 Tubes of Children's Tooth Paste\*\*
