

Inclement Weather Conditions

The order of makeup days will Oct. 24th 2016, Feb. 6th 2017, Mar. 13th 2017 and May 15th 2017. This order will probably differ from Wake County.

Philosophy Statement

- Maintain its status of a recognized private school as outlined within the General Statutes of the State of North Carolina.

Absences

If at any time a child is to be absent from class due to illness or a previously scheduled appointment, **parents must call in** to report the absence of a child each day before 8:30 a.m. Unconfirmed absences will require the school to call the home to check on the absence of a child. Upon returning to school, students must bring a note from the parent or guardian stating the reason for the absence. **Students absent due to contagious illness (measles, etc.) must bring a doctor's note stating that the student's return to school does not jeopardize others.**

Twenty absences from any given class in one academic year may result in the need for the child to repeat the class or possibly be retained to repeat the entire academic year. Unexcused absences will result in disciplinary action as well.

To be counted present a student must be in attendance at least one-half of the student school day. This shall include attendance at official school activities at a place other than school with the approval of the principal. A student shall be in his/her assigned area at the beginning of the school day and the beginning of each class or be recorded as tardy.

Excused Absence

An absence is excused if the following conditions exist:

1. Illness or injury, which makes the student physically unable to attend school.
2. Isolation ordered by the State Board of Health or the Wake County Health Department.
3. Death in family.
4. Medical, dental, or other appointment with a health care provider approved in advance.
5. Court when a student is under subpoena.

Absences not **classified as excused** are unexcused. The student is responsible for submitting a note signed by the parent citing the reason for an absence to the **main office**. Failure to comply with the above will result in the absence being unexcused.

For each excused absence day the student will have two days to make up any homework and/or class work missed. After the allotted time the teacher will average a zero for any incomplete assignments.
